



COVID-19 RENTAL KARTING GUIDELINES

AMR Homestead-Miami Motorplex presented by MG Tires is excited to announce resumption of rental karting operations with the following restrictions.

Guidelines for “Arrive & Drive” and “Private Event” karting:

- We reserve the right to limit persons on property, specifically to ask those who are not actively participating in rental karting to leave the property.
- There is a 8 driver minimum to book a private event
- All patrons are required to wear masks at all times (including while driving)
- All patrons will have temperature scanned during check-in
- Miami-Dade county social distancing guidelines will be followed at all times
- Clubhouse available only for event check-in and limited to 12 persons at a time
- Outside drinks and small snacks are permitted, but no full meals or catering
- We reserve the right to limit persons on property, specifically to ask those who are not actively participating in rental karting to leave the property in order to minimize gathering size.
- There is an 8 driver minimum to book a private event, minimum of 48 hours advance booking required, along with at 50% deposit.
- Per Miami-Dade restrictions, no loitering is permitted before or after event. Time spent on site should be minimized to on-track activity, with spectators being limited to direct family and/or guardians of minor participants.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

****Please note that the following guidelines were REQUIRED by Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida as conditions for AMR Motorplex to re-open. Amenities will be limited to minimize Covid-19 exposure risks. We must enforce these guidelines with a zero tolerance policy.****

1. General

- a. Masks will be required for all persons on site before/during/after their driving experience.
- b. While we are open for rental karting, that is the sole extent of our experience at the moment. We are not at this time able to offer:
 - i. Outdoor picnic tables and seating
 - ii. Indoor tables and seating
 - iii. Additional hangout areas
- c. Customers should be prepared to arrive, drive, and leave in a timely manner to help maintain social distancing and a low total number of customers trackside at any given time.

2. Registration Building, Restrooms, and Point of Sale:

- Our registration building will be limited to registration and checkout, no lounging or resting areas will be provided.
- The entrance to our main building will be restricted to driver registration and payment, and limited to 12 individuals at a time.
 - Positions for those 12 persons are marked on the floor.
 - Web stanchion lanes have been set in place to direct traffic to maintain a minimum of 6' social distancing space.
 - An attendant will be posted at the building entrance (with view of building exit) to maintain the 12 person building load.

- Hand sanitizer stations have been installed inside the building at:
 - The main building entrance (before tablet registration)
 - At the checkout/exit (point of sale) for convenient sanitizing before and after contact with surfaces required for registration and checkout.
- Restrooms use will also be monitored by the building attendant and will be included in the 12 person count.
 - On-site restrooms (2) are single person units, thus are by nature limited to 1 person at a time.
 - Antibacterial soap and no-touch hand dryers are available in each restroom.
- All common touch-points and restrooms will be wiped a minimum of once every two hours as well as at the end of each business day with an anti-bacterial cleaning solution.
- The main building will have a deep clean consisting of complete surface wipe-down, sweep, and mop at a minimum of once per week.

3. Outdoor Common Areas and Rental Karting Equipment

- Outdoor common area amenities will be minimized to discourage people from gathering.
- Markers have been painted throughout the outdoor areas to mark and remind patrons of social distancing guidelines. These are NOT optional.
- Social distancing guidelines will be integrated into all aspects of the outdoor operation to include:
 - Viewing
 - Helmet Fitting
 - Pre-Ride Safety briefing
 - Rider loading/unloading.
- All rental helmets will be sanitized between each and every use with a UV-C ultraviolet light sanitation system.
- All rental karts will have user contact points (ie. steering wheels and restraints) wiped down with an anti-bacterial cleaner between each use.
- All common area touch points (ie. gates, shelves, etc.) will be wiped down with anti-bacterial cleaners at least once every two hours.
- We will perform a complete exterior surface wipe-down of each kart weekly before opening on Wednesdays with an anti-bacterial cleaner.

- An outdoor hand sanitizer station is available at the load/unload point for sanitizing pre-load and post-load.

4. Staff Precautions

- All current staff have been trained on social distancing policies and COVID-19 prevention measures.
- All staff will be screened for elevated temperature upon arrival for their shift.
 - If any elevated temperatures are detected, the employee will be sent home for further evaluation and/or quarantine at their discretion. The employee must provide clearance from the doctor to return to work.
- All employees will be required to wear masks at all times when in close proximity to customers, and at all times otherwise with the exception of highly strenuous activities.
